HIV & HEP C TESTING HIV testing with \$20 Kroger gift card for each person tested.


SYRINGE EXCHANGE Safe syringe exchange every 1st and 3rd Thursday of the month.

## OUTREACH

SEB continues to focus on community outreach as a way to engage potential clients, and help meet the immediate needs of our LGBTQ+ houseless individuals. Supplies and funds donated to SEB to support toiletry packets, food and water, and an array of clothing items has been extremely helpful. SEB outreach occurs every 2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month. Preassembled hygiene, snack, and safety kits are handed out to individuals at camp sites in the Louisville Metro area.

Sweet Evening Breeze currently has 35 volunteers engaged in services. We wish to thank EVERY ONE of them for their hard work and continued investment in what we do. ## NEXT PHASE...

As Sweet Evening Breeze, wraps up phase II of its strategic plan, we are gearing up for the most important element of the organization's growth, which includes adding the residential component to our current services. As we move into phase III (offering housing units for clients), we will begin exploring properties around Louisville for an LGBTQ+ residential and support center for our clients. The Center will provide transitional housing, 15-20 units/beds, day shelter services, individual clinical and therapy support, case management, laundry facilities, showers, a pantry/kitchen, and all of the services we currently offer.
